BY-LAW NO. 2: ELECTION OF STANDING COMMITTEE CHAIR AND VICE-CHAIR - 2

- 1.0** All Committees of the Whole must have a Chair and Vice-Chair.
- 2.0** At the first Committee of the Whole (ie. Property and Finance, Human Resources etc.) meeting in each year a formal election will be held for each of these positions.
- 3.0** The Chair of the Board will preside and run the election for the Chair of the Committee of the Whole in the same format as the election for Chair of the Board.
- 4.0** The Vice-Chair election of the Committee of the Whole will be presided over by the newly appointed Committee of the Whole Chair in the same format as the election for the Vice-Chair.
- 5.0** The Chair of the Committee shall seek by motion of simple majority to destroy voting ballots immediately. If the motion for immediate destruction of the ballots is defeated, they shall be placed in an envelope with the Chair of the Board signing across the seal. They shall be kept for 30 days and then destroyed.
